**Health Department Offering Free Hearing and Vision Screening June Through August**

The St. Clair County Health Department is offering free hearing and vision screening for any child entering preschool or kindergarten in the Fall. Appointments are available and walk-ins will also be accepted. The Health Department is located at 3415 28th Street, in Port Huron.

**Screening Schedule:**

**June and July**

**Monday through Friday**

**8:30am – 4:00pm (not available from 12:00-1:00)**

**\*No screening available on July 7\***

**August**

**Mondays: 10:30am – 6:00pm (not available from 2:00-3:00)**

**Tuesday through Friday 8:30am – 4:00pm (not available from 12:00-1:00)**

Why should children be screened?

- All children must have a hearing and vision screen before entering kindergarten.
- Screening can help your child succeed in school. An undiagnosed hearing and vision problem can interfere with your child's development.
- St. Clair County Health Department under the direction of the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services is committed to providing children with hearing and vision screening to ensure they have the skills necessary to succeed in school and learning.
- Early diagnosis and treatment can help prevent temporary difficulties from becoming permanent problems.
