## Free KN95 Masks Available

The St. Clair County Health Department (SCCHD) in partnership with the St. Clair County Library System has **free** adult KN95 masks available for the public (while supplies last) at all <u>St. Clair County Library branch locations</u> and the <u>St. Clair County Health Department</u>, main office. Pick up times are during regular business hours. Limit three masks per person.

As COVID-19 continues on with the presence of the highly contagious Omicron variant, getting vaccinated and boosted, as well as wearing a <u>well-fitting mask</u> over your mouth and nose in indoor public settings or crowds is crucial to protect yourself and others from COVID-19.
