Power Outage

St Clair County Emergency Operation Center (EOC) is partially activated. The county has approximately 30,000 DTE customers without power. DTE Energy will release a restoration update around noon today. Power outage is expected to last an extended period of time up to 72 hours. If you need emergency medical assistance please call 9-1-1. For non-life threatening oxygen refills please call your medical supplier first or St. Clair County Central Dispatch at 810-985-8115 or Clay Township Dispatch at 810-794-9381. If you need to charge your medical devices, Home Depot – Fort Gratiot, Lowe’s- Fort Gratiot and Menard’s – Port Huron have zones setup in their stores to charge only medical devices for free during normal store hours.

Community Warming Centers and charging stations have been setup throughout the county. Here are the locations lists, these facilities will be open normal business hours.
