Time Capsule Found at Previous Jail on Bard Street, Port Huron

St. Clair County has been in the process of demolishing structures over the course of the past couple months, including the previous Juvenile Center, Economic Opportunity Commission, Day Treatment/Night Watch Center and the Jail. The previous St. Clair County Jail was being demolished this week. The contractor, Dore & Associates Contracting Inc., saved the cornerstone, which notes the original build was in 1953. The time capsule was found at the cornerstone of the structure and was excavated on Tuesday.

The St. Clair County Sheriff, Tim Donnellon, and other county officials will be opening the time capsule today at 2:30 p.m. in the St. Clair County Administrative Office Building, 200 Grand River Avenue, in the Sheriff's Office on the 2nd Floor, Suite 203. The media is invited to attend and chronicle the revealing of the time capsule.
