- Each patch would have several requirements for the child (ren) to complete. Once this is accomplished, the child (ren) would take a signed form to one of the designated locations, such as police and fire departments, government halls, etc. throughout the county to receive their patch.
- When a child (ren) receives all six patches, they would be invited to their local governmental meeting to receive a certificate.

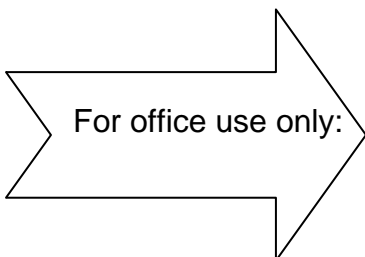
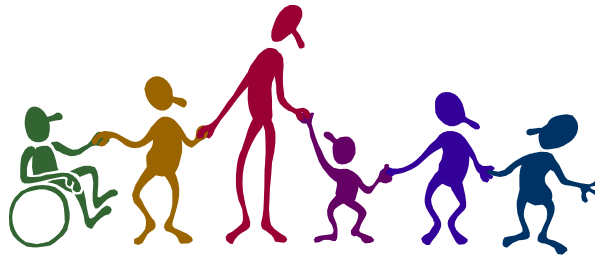
