

Lesson III: Weather Information:

Parent Instruction:

- Review the weather information Lesson with your child (ren).
- Have your child (ren) memorize the local radio station call signs and numbers to listen for hazardous related weather: WSAQ 107.1 and WGRT 102.3
- Complete the weather related word search

Lesson Discussion:

We have discussed the cloud types, what you should know in weather related incident, and critical weather terms. Now, we need to discuss where to tune into for potential hazardous weather in our area. It has been recommended to listen to an All-Hazard NOAA Weather Radio, or local radio, television and cable stations for the latest updates on hazardous weather. Our local radio stations are WSAQ 107.1 and WGRT 102.3 to hear the most up-to-date and accurate weather information.

For All-Hazards NOAA Weather Radio information, including a station near you, see the NOAA Weather Radio page on the Internet at <http://www.nws.noaa.gov/nwr> or contact your National Weather Service office. Most importantly to ensure a continuous flow of weather information make sure the NOAA Weather Radio, or another radio or television has a battery backup.
