

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, in cooperation with the firm named below, today announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately unless otherwise instructed.

**Name of Product:** Homelite, Husky and Black Max Brand Generators

**Units:** About 51,750

**Distributor:** Homelite Consumer Products Inc., of Anderson, S.C.

**Hazard:** The fuel gauge can leak excessive amounts of gasoline, posing a fire hazard to consumers.

**Incidents/Injuries:** None reported.

**Description:** This recall involves Homelite and Husky brand generators sold exclusively at Home Depot stores and Black Max brand generators sold exclusively at Sam's Club stores. Affected generators include Homelite models HG3500, HG3510, HG5700 and HG5700R, Husky models HU3650, HUCA5700 and HUCA7000 and Black Max models BM10700A, BM10700B, BM10711A, BM10700DG, BM10700R, BM10700BR & BM10722G. Generators included in this recall have manufacturing date codes between BML306-BMM151, CHL122-CHM151 and CRL153-CRM059. The model number and manufacturing date code are included on the data label located on the top or side of the generator engine. Products with a green "dot" on the outside of the package or a "silver dot" on the fuel gauge face are not included in the recall. Sold exclusively at: Home Depot and Sam's Club stores nationwide from July 2008 through May 2009 for between \$480 and \$1,600.
