***St. Clair County Health Department Now Offering Flu Vaccinations***

Flu vaccinations are now available, while supplies last, on a walk-in basis Mondays from 10:00am - 6:00pm and Wednesdays 8:00am - 4:00pm (through November 14) at the St. Clair County Health Department main office located at 3415 28<sup>th</sup> Street in Port Huron. By appointment, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

We offer flu vaccines that protect against four (4) strains of flu. Also available is the High Dose flu vaccine, for adults 65 years of age and older that protects against three (3) strains of flu. A flu vaccination is necessary every year, and is the best prevention anyone 6 months of age or older has against flu.

For those uninsured or underinsured, cost will vary based on income eligibility and family size. Most insurance is accepted and considers flu vaccination a covered benefit.
