A Food Service Management Certification Course

This course is available to anyone in the food industry who wants to become ServSafe Certified. This certification is recognized nationwide and is valid for five years. A variety of food safety topics will be discussed. This course will fulfill Michigan Food Law of 2000 (Act No. 92 of 2000, as amended) requirement that: "One person per establishment must be certified in a food safety Management Certification Course".

WHERE: All classes are held at the St. Clair County Health Department

WHAT: The first three classes will be spent reviewing and preparing for the certification examination. An applicant must successfully pass (75%) the examination to receive the ServSafe certificate.
