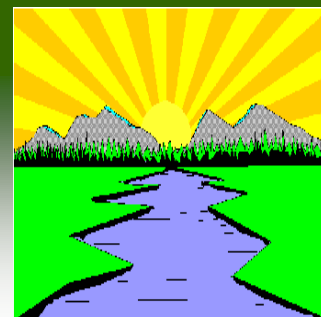
**NOTE: If you don't have a stream, feel free to join other county youth at the Pine River at Goodells County Park at 11 a.m. We will meet near the horse arena.**
