St. Clair County Parks is proud to offer the Memorial Bench, Brick & Tree program for all three of the county parks and the Wadhams to Avoca Trail. Goodells County Park, Fort Gratiot County Park and Columbus County Park all have designated areas for recognition. Please note that requests for placement locations are subject to approval by the Parks Commission. Some areas in the parks and on the Wadhams to Avoca Trail may not be available. County Parks will maintain the memorial gift during its normal lifespan. If a memorial gift is damaged by nature, vandalism or accident, County Parks will replace the item at no charge to the donor. Please note that due to seasonal changes, park events and material orders, it may take up to six months for installation of memorial gifts.
