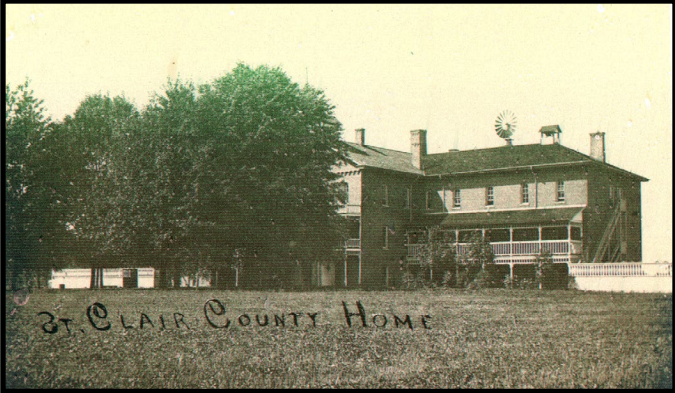

The new infirmary under construction in 1914. Looking northeast.



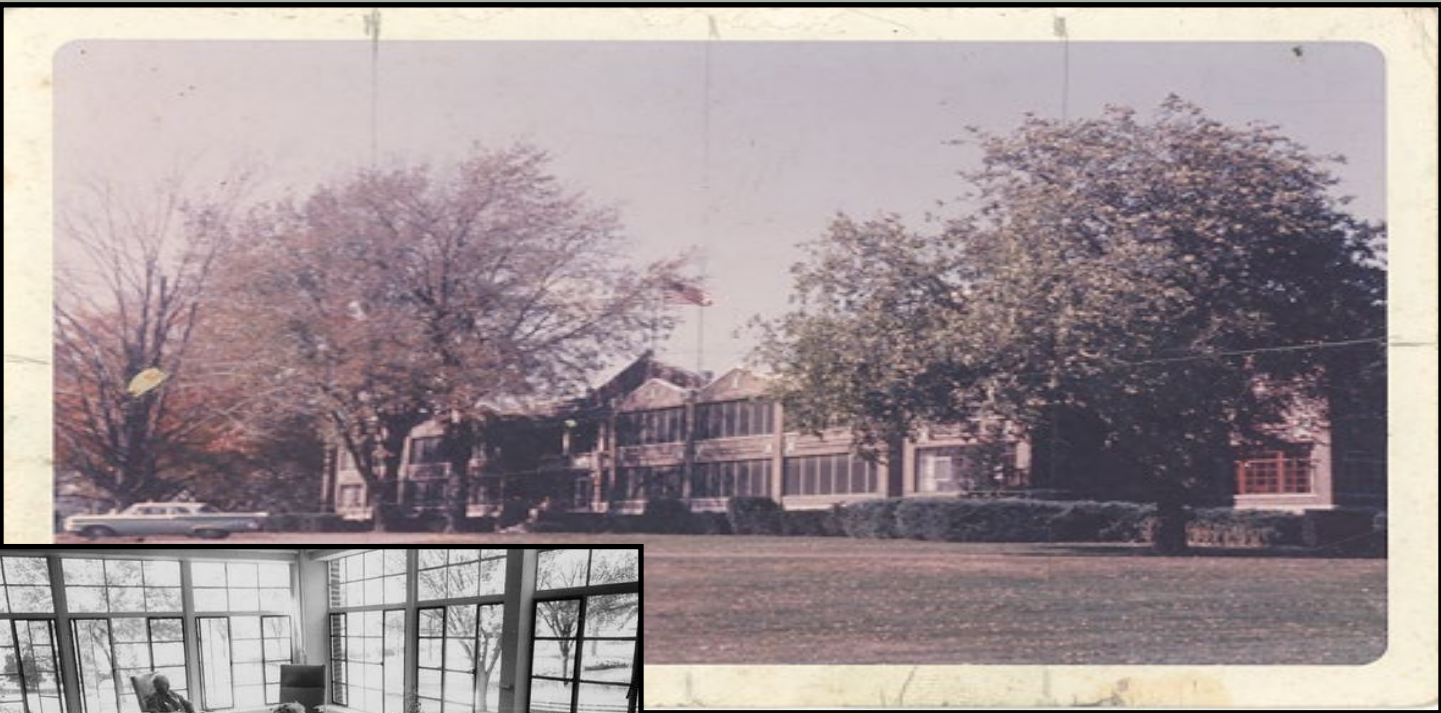
The dedication ceremony of the new Infirmary in June of 1915.
