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### Additional Impacts to St. Clair County Operations

Governor Whitmer issued Executive Order 2020-9 earlier today temporarily closing various public gathering places. As a result the following operational changes went into effect at 3:00 today and will continue through March 30, 2020.

The Library System, including all branches are closed to the public. Any items on hold will remain as such until operations resume. All due dates will be adjusted. Please do not return items to the drop box until operations resume. Reservations for use of buildings located at the St. Clair County Parks and Recreation Commission through March 30, 2020 will not be accepted.

Reservations for outside use of the St. Clair County Administrative Office Building Auditorium and Conference Rooms through March 30, 2020 will not be accepted.

In addition the changes mandated by the State of Michigan, the St. Clair County Treasurer's Office and the Register of Deeds Office will transition to in person service by appointment only effective March 17, 2020.
