St. Clair County Coastal Community Flooding – Coast Guard Operations

Coastal communities in St. Clair County continue to experience flooding.

The United States Coast Guard has provided an update on ice cutter operations.

The US Coast Guard Cutter Bristol Bay has returned to Detroit for refueling. Neah Bay is currently operating between Willow Point and Roberts Landing. The ice brash in that area has been loosened and is 12 to 16 inches thick. The Griffon is operating in the lower portion of the St. Clair River. The Samuel Risley is operating between Russell Island and Marine City. Two additional ships were added at 10:00 am as escorts down the St. Clair River that will assist in flushing operations.
