**St. Clair County Health Department Urges Residents to Drive with Caution
Vaccine Clinic Scheduled for February 16 Will Remain Open**

The St. Clair County Health Department (SCCHD) will continue providing COVID-19 vaccinations for those with appointments tomorrow (February 16) at the Blue Water Convention Center (BWCC). This is a scheduled *second dose* vaccination clinic.

With the expected snow and hazardous road conditions, the following is in place:

- The clinic is scheduled from 10:00am – 7:00pm (subject to change)
- Everyone is reminded to proceed with caution if going out.
- Late arrivals will be accommodated. If you keep your appointment, take your time and use extra caution to arrive safely.
- If you cannot make your appointment tomorrow, another clinic is scheduled on Thursday, February 18 from 10:00-7:00 at the BWCC. You may keep your same appointment time and we will work you in. Some delays may occur, and patience is appreciated.
- If you are unable to attend tomorrow or at the same time on Thursday, notify the SCCHD at (810) 987-5300 or (810) 966-4163; or send an email to covid19@stclaircounty.org – a make-up clinic will be scheduled if needed.

If you arrive early for your vaccination appointment, please remain in your car until a few minutes before your scheduled time. You may check in starting 5 minutes before your scheduled time.

St. Clair County Health Department continues to work with partner organizations and volunteers to vaccinate eligible individuals as quickly as possible and using all available vaccine doses each week. Vaccine information is available at www.scchealth.co
