

Resolution 26-17

ERRATA RESOLUTION Regarding Proposed Renewal of St. Clair County Ambulance Services Millage

Whereas, on May 7, 2026, the Board of Commissioners of the County of St. Clair, MI approved Resolution 26-15 Placing Proposed Renewal of St. Clair County Ambulance Services Millage on Ballot (the “Resolution”);

Whereas, the Resolution included proposed ballot language for the Proposed Renewal of St. Clair County Ambulance Services Millage (the “Ballot Language”);

Whereas, the Ballot Language contained a clerical error that the St. Clair County Board of Commissioners desires to fix pursuant to this Errata Resolution, specifically, the word “to” was missing in a portion of the Ballot Language;

Whereas, the Ballot Language should read as follows, with the underline denoting the correction; and

RENEWAL OF ST. CLAIR COUNTY AMBULANCE SERVICES MILLAGE

To raise funds to be used and disbursed to local municipalities for the sole purpose of providing operating and capital funds for ambulance service in St. Clair County, shall St. Clair County be authorized to levy a millage of 0.5000 mills (\$.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) per year which has been reduced to .4993 mills (\$.4993 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by required rollbacks, constituting renewal of a previously approved voter authorized millage, for a period of four (4) years, being 2026 through 2029 inclusive? If approved, this renewed millage is estimated to generate \$4,330,595 in revenue in its first year. Provided, some funds may be captured by other local units of government or tax increment financing authorities as required by law.

Whereas, correcting the clerical error in the Ballot Language does not alter the intent or substance of the Resolution or the Ballot Language.

Now, Therefore, Be it resolved that:

The Clerk of the County of St. Clair is hereby directed to place on the ballot for the primary election of August 4, 2026, a proposition to renew the imposition of a millage to be used for the sole purpose of providing ambulance services in the County of St. Clair, and that the proposition shall be placed on the ballot in the following form which shall replace the language previously approved pursuant to Resolution 26-15:

RENEWAL OF ST. CLAIR COUNTY AMBULANCE SERVICES MILLAGE

1. To raise funds to be used and disbursed to local municipalities for the sole purpose of providing operating and capital funds for ambulance service in St. Clair County, shall St. Clair County be authorized to levy a millage of 0.5000 mills (\$.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) per year which has been reduced to .4993 mills (\$.4993 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by required rollbacks, constituting renewal of a previously approved voter authorized millage, for a period of four (4) years, being 2026 through 2029 inclusive? If approved, this renewed millage is estimated to generate \$4,330,595 in revenue in its first year. Provided, some funds may be captured by other local units of government or tax increment financing authorities as required by law.
2. Said election shall be held and conducted and the results of the said election shall be canvassed in accordance with the provisions of the State law pertaining to the submission of such questions to the electors entitled to vote thereon and that the County Clerk of St. Clair County and the Treasurer of St. Clair County shall do and perform all acts required by law for the calling and effecting of such election, and that the said Clerk shall within five (5) days of said election file with the County Treasurer for St. Clair County a certified copy of the official declaration of the results of said election.
