COUNTY MEDAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. It is <u>recommended</u> that the applicant be between the age of 12 and 14 years of age by January 1st if you began the program at age 9. Otherwise it is recommended that you be in your 3rd to 5th year in the program.
- 2. Members <u>must be currently and previously enrolled</u> in the project area or related area. You may contact the MSU Extension 4-H staff to verify if you did enroll in the project area in which you are applying. Don't assume, verify.
- 3. The application form **must be completed by the member themselves**, either handwritten or typed. Any evidence of parent involvement will be grounds for disqualification.
- 4. The due date will be **December 1st**
- 5. Member must fill out one application for each project or related area in which they are applying for a medal.
- 6. Member may only be awarded two medals per year and only once in a specific project area for the duration of their 4-H career, but are not limited to the number of project areas they apply for.
