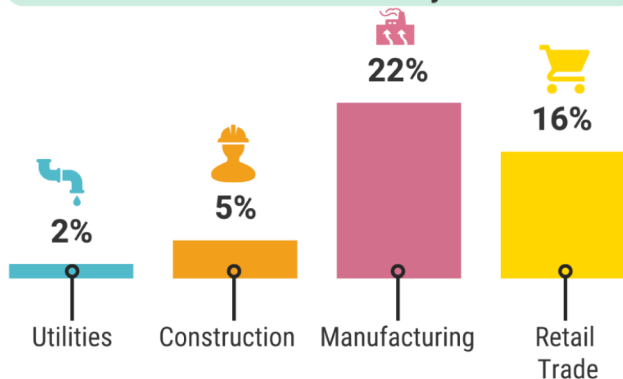

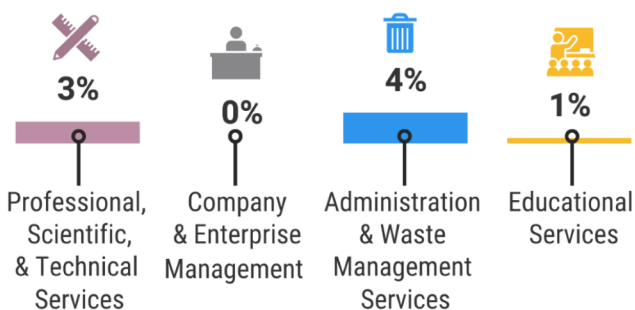

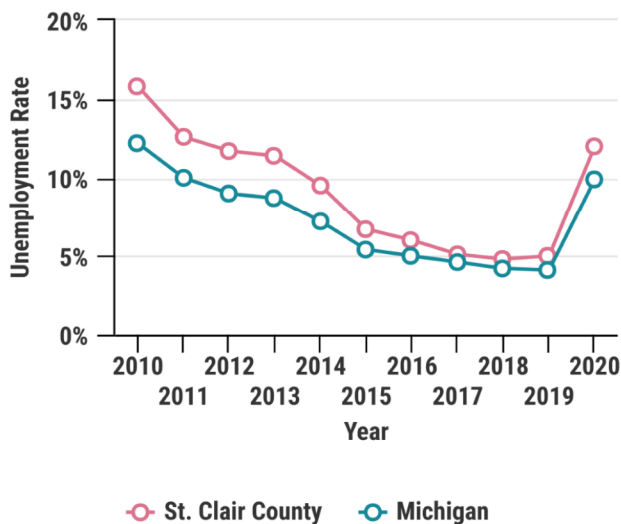

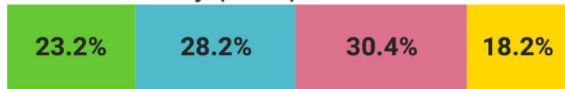
Age 2019

St. Clair County has seen a decline in all age groups from 2010-2019 with the highest decrease in those aged 44 and under.

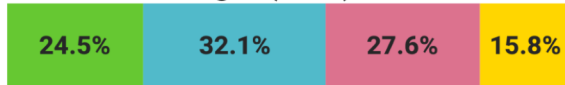
Age Groups

St. Clair County (2019)



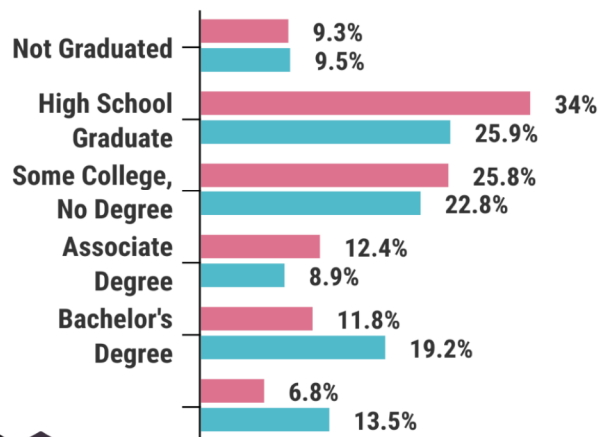
Southeast Michigan (2019)

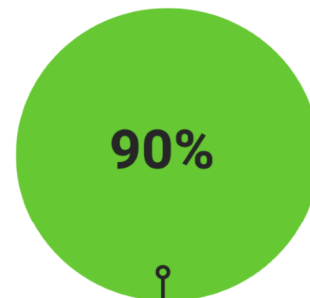
