The Park is open daily from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. April through October, 8 a.m. - 9 p.m. November through March. Admission is free (except during some special events).

The Splashpad is open Memorial Day through Labor Day. The hours of operation are 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. Admission is free!

Pets are allowed in the park (except during certain events). Pets must be kept on a leash and owners must clean up after their pets.

Reservations are required for exclusive use of any park facility. For reservation information, call (810) 989-6960.

Smoking is prohibited in all St. Clair County Park properties.

The park has a variety of options to satisfy your facility rental needs. Receptions, graduation parties, family reunions and weddings are just a few of the possibilities. Make your reservation today!



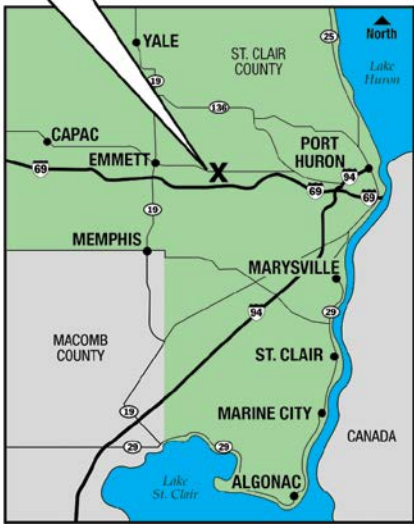
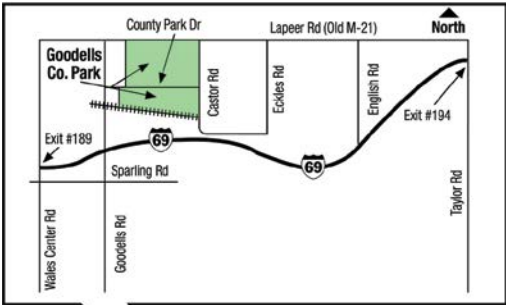
County Parks Information

Unique Features:

The Historical Village, which includes the Murphy/ Ryan Farmhouse (1872), Lynn Township School (1885), C.C. Peck Bank (1908), the Mudge Log Cabin (1863) and the Columbus Bible Church (1860) are tributes to St. Clair County’s rich history.

The St. Clair County Farm Museum represents over 150 years of farming in the county. The museum is housed in the historic barns of the St. Clair County Poor Farm/Medical Centre (1873-1993).

The Butterfly Garden provides the perfect place for some quiet reflection, while providing a colorful habitat for caterpillars and butterflies.

The BMX track allows members to compete on a challenging and exciting race course.

Radio controlled model cars, trucks and planes find action and excitement at the RC dirt track and the Propbusters airfield.

The park features two playground areas that offer equipment for children of all ages. Features include slides, spring toys, an accessible swing, a climbing ramp, an 18ft slide glider and engineered safety surfacing.

The Splashpad, features 11 different spray elements that include spray cannons, dumping buckets, ground geysers and water tunnel !

Equestrian areas provide opportunities for young people and adults alike to develop or strengthen their horse handling skills.

The beautiful setting at Goodells County Park makes it the ideal place for an outdoor wedding. There are several options for the reception afterwards too!
