


SNAPSHOT:

Substance use during adolescence is related to a wide variety of negative outcomes, such as STDs, including HIV.^{6,28} This report focuses on three aspects of substance use: the percentage of high school students who ever used select illicit drugs, defined here as cocaine, inhalants, heroin, or methamphetamines; the percentage of high school students who ever injected illegal drugs; the percentage of students who used marijuana or synthetic marijuana; and the percentage of high school students who ever misused prescription opioids, defined here as ever having used prescription pain medication, such as codeine, Vicodin, OxyContin, Hydrocodone, or Percocet, without a prescription or differently than indicated by a doctor. Injection drug use places adolescents at direct risk for HIV, while drug use, regardless of mode of administration, places adolescents at risk of overdose. Drug use is also associated with sexual risk behavior, experience of violence, and mental health and suicide risks ¹








1% of St. Clair County 11th grade students have ever used cocaine ^{1a,2a}

1% of St. Clair County 11th grade students have ever used inhalants such as glue, hair spray, air fresheners etc. in the last 30 days ^{1a,2a}












SNAPSHOT:

Use of tobacco and drinking alcohol can have numerous harmful effects on adolescent health. Drinking alcohol at an early age can lead to underdevelopment of the brain and excessive consumption can lead to liver diseases in the future. Tobacco use can cause lung cancer, diabetes, cancer and even blindness ^{2,3}







More than 50% of St. Clair County 11th grade students ever drank alcohol^{1a,2a}

Almost 10% of St. Clair County 11th grade students had their first drink of alcohol before age 13^{1a,2a}








More than 30% of St. Clair County 11th grade students drink alcohol currently ^{1a,2a}




Violence is a leading cause of death and nonfatal injuries among adolescents in the United States. Violence victimization (that is, to be a victim of violence) places the lives of adolescents at risk, and the experience may be associated with trauma, diminished academic success, sexual risk behavior, substance use, and risk of STDs, including HIV.

The YRBS and MiPHY includes a number of measures of violence victimization related to safety at school, bullying, dating violence, and forced sex. At least two questions assessed experiences and perceptions of school safety, including being threatened or injured with a weapon at school in the past year and missing school because of safety concerns in the past month. Some questions also assessed experiences of bullying in the past year, including bullying at school and electronic bullying. Two questions assessed whether students had experienced physical or sexual dating violence in the past year. ¹








SNAPSHOT:

Poor mental health can result in serious negative outcomes for the health and development of adolescents. It can lead to risky sexual behavior, illicit substance use, adolescent pregnancy, school absences/dropout, and other delinquent behaviors.

Mental health is measured in the YRBS and the MiPHY with one question addressing persistent feelings of sadness or hopelessness and four questions on suicide ideation or action. Persistent feelings of sadness or hopelessness is defined in the survey as feeling sad or hopeless almost every day for two weeks or more in a row in the past year. Suicide ideation or action questions assess consideration of and planning for suicide, attempting suicide, and being medically treated for suicide attempts. ¹




Almost 1 out of 2 St. Clair County 11th grade students have felt so sad or hopeless they stopped doing usual activities ^{1a,2a}






Sexual intercourse at a young age can have far-reaching consequences later on in life. Sexual intercourse can lead to unintended pregnancy. In fact, among women aged 19 years or younger, more than 4 out of 5 pregnancies were unintended. The proportion of unintended was highest among teens younger than age 15 at 98%. Sexual intercourse can also spread STDs. The CDC estimates that youth ages 15-24 account for half of the 20 million new sexually transmitted infections in the US. STDs can lead to fever, rash, painful urination sore lymph nodes etc. ^{4,5}






Almost 50% of St. Clair County I I th grade students have ever had sexual intercourse ^{1a,2a}











About 10% of St. Clair County 11th grade students had sexual intercourse with 4 or more people during their life ^{1a,2a}






More than 1 out of 3 St. Clair County 11th grade students are currently sexually active (had sexual intercourse within 3 months)^{1a,2a}




People who have obesity compared to those with a healthy weight are at an


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


